He propounded the 3 basic theories as -

<sup>1st</sup>.The Human Resources of the State is an absolute Asset, it can be valued and would be utilised as monetary fund for initial Capital investment for generating production sources. Through this process, the Human race shall get rid of Poverty, inequality and unemployment, (as per the Human Resource Economic System).

That means the dependency of the Human Race on Capitalism shall be over, as well as present Socialism and Capitalism shall be ended, on which the World's economic System running in the present time.

<sup>2nd</sup>.Parliament/ Legislative Assembly/Governing Body never be considered an absolute representation of the Republic of State. On the ground, the personal interests of the Elected person can never be the same as the interest of the Republic of State (as per Contemporary Jurisprudence) That means the present Democratic System Worldwide has been declared null and void.

<sup>3rd</sup>.The Judiciary System of the State has been declared a State Body and, never be treated as an independent body of the State.

That means present Judiciary Systems Worldwide has been declared as Null and Void. All grounds for the aforementioned criticism seem to be valid and correct.

Therefore, first time in history, the present entirely Economic System, Political, Democratic, Social and Judiciary System has been declared as null and void on valid grounds historically.

## **2. Human Capital Monitisation Economic System**

It is claimed to be a new economic model, but in reality, it appears to be more of a new economic system. According to me, if this economic system proves itself, then it will prove to be the latest and highest innovation in the field of economics in the last 4,000 years.

The biggest surprise is that this system challenges the principle number two mentioned above, which includes the valuation of direct human resources instead of rare amenities. If this system stands the test of the cardinal principles of economics, it will completely change our current economics model. Its first claim was issued by WIPO in the year 2021, in which the basic principle, mechanism, tools and other information of this economics format was published.

### **According to this Economic technology -**

- a. State shall establish an additional autonomous body as State H.R. Account with a similar power to the Central Bank of State, Stock Exchange and Ministry of Finance.
- b. State shall be maintaining the aforesaid Account for registering all working Human Resource into State H.R. Account of all working or futuristic Human Resource at the State Level.
- c. State shall be calculating the valuation of State H.R. Account at an individual level.
- d. State shall be claiming the cumulative valuation of State H.R. Account into the assets side of the state balance sheet.
- e. thereafter State shall be capable of issuing the credit note of certain valuation for initial capital investment in favour of registered working professionals on demand to maintain the liability of the State H.R. Account.

- g. Aforesaid credit note shall be monetised by the Central Bank of State in the form of debt to a group of Credit Note holders for the establishment of new industrial units, whereas security against Debt shall be aforesaid credit Note and hypothecation agreement of creation of assets from Debt/loan amount. After the establishment of the Industrial unit, the group of Credit Note holder shall be repaying the Debt amount to the Central Bank of State for discharge of the Credit Note. After discharge of the Credit Note from the Central Bank of State, the liability of State H.R. Account shall be declared as nil, and ownership of aforesaid industry shall be transferred in favour of the group of Credit Note Holder (for a limited time not treat as welfare scheme).

### 2.1 This proposed economic system is based on 4 main principles.

Human resource is an absolute asset.

- Human resource to be valued in the form of a unit.
- Human resource is being part of the State H.R. Capital account.
- After registering the H.R. in the State Capital account, it's eligible to utilise likewise as conversion into monetary Fund/currency fund.

### 2.2 For implementation of this Economic System desired state to be followed

- Formed the state H.R. capital account at the national level.
- Registered all working human resource into National H.R. Capital account at an individual level.
- Evaluate the aforesaid Human Resource through the proposed valuation formulas. Issue the Credit Guarantee against aforesaid valuation (for a limited time not treat as welfare scheme).
- Aforesaid Assets to be converted into a monetary fund, through the mechanism of Manpower Grid, as important tool of H.R. Monetisation Economic System
- Utilized the aforesaid fund for economic operation or initial investments in form of capital formation for establishment of new industrial establishment.

**2.3 Tools of proposed H.R. Monetisation Economic System** – the inventor of H.R. Economic System Mr. Deepak Sharma (often called as founder/Father of H.R. Economics) being an Indian Economist proposed the various tools in same regard as valuations methods, accounting Standards, economic

standards.

- Economic Standards and their connectivity with H.R. Accounting standards.
- Derivative / marketing H.R. Coefficient.

- Connectivity of H.R. Grid with the central bank of the state, finance Ministry, and Stock Exchange for conversion and reverse process of H.R. Valuation into Monetary Fund.

### 2.4 Proposed Mechanism –

Man Power Grid is the most important tool of H.R. Economic Model, in the true sense this is the actual foundation, on the basis of which H.R. Economic Model will be implemented, its first task is to

register the Human Resource at the state level, after the above registration. Its valuation is to be determined by the given formula, along with that it is to approve a provisional composite guarantee to the particular person who has given its registration application. Apart from this, Main Power Grid will register the person's registration application according to his work capabilities, in different types of areas in which the person's services can be availed, or in which areas the person can provide service, in which the person can Will be able to choose areas according to interest.

The second phase of Main Power Grid is one of the most important phases in which any entrepreneur can present before the Main Power Grid regarding any viable and feasible project. After checking the above project from all economic aspect, marketing aspect, financially parameter as well as legal formalities, Main Power Grid make satisfied in that case it might be release preapproval, that project to enter in public domain, After release in the public domain, the above entrepreneur can put the above project in front of the members (already having pre Composite Guarantee certificate) belonging with area and request the composite guarantee in favour of that project from the above members. After which any registered member (as mentioned in the first step) can issue his approval in favour of the above project. Then, Manpower shall be calculating the all the approvals coming in support of that project, thereafter calculate the value of total composite guarantee. After which the total cost of starting the project and the amount of composite guarantee will be matched. If the amount of composite guarantee is greater than cost of project, in that case approval/sanction certificate will be generated in favour of project by and behalf of manpower grid. After issue the certificate, all the participants will have to pledge their indemnity Bond before the Man Power Grid. Against the above indemnity bond, the Man Power Grid will issue a Credit Guarantee Note in favor of the project, which the entrepreneur will submit to the Central Bank, after which the above fund will be released in favor of the project by banking arrangement, herein the Central.

Bank already has the Composite Guarantee Note of Man Power Grid, so the primary responsibility of debt repayment is of Man Power Grid, in which Main Power Grid will give direction and instruction to the above project participants. the project participants will repay the loan after the project is commissioned, after payment of entire loan amount, taking back their composite guarantee from the Central Bank, which will then return it to the manpower grid. after

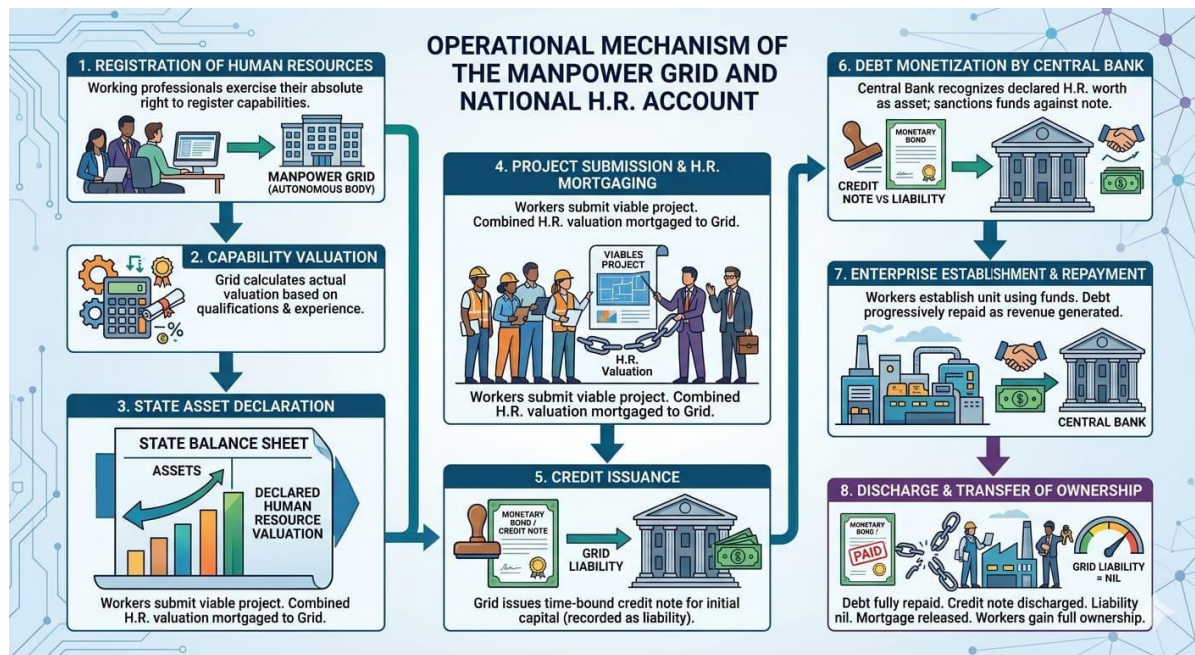
back C.G back to Manpower Grid. The control and ownership will be with the participants, before that the main control over the above project will remain of Manpower grid.

**2.5 A comparison of Deepak Sharma with Adam smith and Karl Marx-** from the above discussion we compare Deepak Sharma with Hon'ble Adam Smith and Karl Marx some basic differences have been considerable as under-

**1st-** if we have to count the record of Philosophy since ancient Era, the first codification, the first philosophy for about Private and Public Property has been codified by Aristotle and Plato during 400 B.C. meanwhile Adam smith as father of Capitalism more emphasis upon codification upon Private Property and Capitalism, free market, and production of Resources run through the Capitalism during 1776, due to Crony Capitalism impact Karl Marx (1850) more emphasis upon Production of resources should be established by State or through Socialism. Meanwhile Socialism has been failed due to inefficiency, Corruption, Communist ideology, on the other hand Deepak Sharma has been proposed the Human Resource Economic System with out any Record of Philosophical History, he more emphasis upon power of intellectualism, and provide the appropriate solution how to utilised the monetisation of intellectualism of State for establishment of new industries of resources.

**2nd-** if we count ideological perspective of Adam Smith support the Capitalism and Karl Marx support the Socialism, meanwhile Deepak Sharma more emphasis upon intellectualism, in the criticisms of Capitalism the solution of Crony Capitalism has not provided by Adam Smith, while Socialism has been ruled out due to failure of Corruption, inefficiency of Production, arise of communist ideology. On the other hand, Human Resource Economic System seem to solve the Crony Capitalism, corruption, increase the high-level production and various other issues.

**3rd-** if we count Economic Perspective, in the Capitalism the production of resources shall be established and controlled by a group of Capitalist for profit and wealth earning perspective, meanwhile production of resources has been established and controlled by State is recognised as Socialism, on the other hand, the production of Resources shall be established and controlled by a group of intellectual as well as working professionals as per Human Resource Economic System.



### 3. School of Contemporary Jurisprudence

-Mr. Deepak Sharma (often called as Father/ Founder of Contemporary Jurisprudence) propounded the school of Contemporary Jurisprudence. He has challenged the cardinal principle of the current Judiciary and Democratic jurisprudence.

He criticizes the current Democratic and Democratic System on the grounds that –

A) **Parliament /Legislative Assembly** could not be considered as the absolute representative session of the Republic of State, because the personal interest of an elected person (M.P/MLA) is never the same as the collective interest of the Republic of State.

B) **Judiciary system** – The school of Contemporary Jurisprudence also challenged the cardinal principle of the current Judiciary system, as

- a) Judges/ bench never be considered as an independent Judiciary body, on the ground, that the Court can't be treated as an independent Judiciary body because of various functionalities of the court/ Judges run under the control of the State, the decisions of a judge may be biased in case of State Vs Republic.
- b) Judiciary body of State not adopt the election process, therefore never be considered as independent body of State.
- c) Current Bar - Bench and three-layer Lower Court, High Court, and Supreme Court is a Decentralized Judicial System is not suitable for large population States. He proposed first time the centralized trial Judicial System, to be discussed in detail below.

From the above Statement of Mr. Deepak Sharma, from above Statement, he codified that the Judiciary System is being a Part of the State, not an independent body and Parliament not having Absolute representation of the Republic of State. From my point of view aforesaid criticism ground seem to be reasonable and validated, most probably, my opinion shall be acceptable by the general public as well as a group of Hon'ble Jurists.

#### 3.1 In support of resolving the aforesaid problem, he segregates the Law into Five types based on

- a) Economic Development
- b) Religious, Rituals, and Custom values
- c) limit to use of nature resources
- d) personal interest (education, health) and survival effort.
- e) Civilization/ public interest.
- f) On the base of the above Law formation.

He propounded the three levels of the Democratic structure against Public-Parliament, and he propounded the three-level Representative sessions as a Public-Society Representation-Parliament/Legislative assembly. He emphasises on the point, that the same group of people have a common interest in their economic survival, such type of group is called as a Society, (As Advocate, Farmers, Student, labour), therefore, any representative person from such society shall be called as a society representative, the naturally common interest of such representative shall be the same as society common interest.

He further States, that such society representatives shall be a mandatory part of Parliament or legislative assembly, in the role of the opposition of States.

Whereas, the Elected member of parliament shall be part of the Govt, which represents the State.

He further propounded that Parliament (ruling/State) and society representation (opposition) both shall participate in the Law-making process jointly, thereafter the degree of democracy must be increased.

The power distribution of Law Formation shall be codified and transparent between Govt and opposition on the basis of category of Law (whereas Law has been divided into Five Types).

The selection of members of Parliament should be through the Election procedure. The tenure shall be fixed for the next Election due date (4-5 years), while the Representation of Society Representative before Parliament ought to be dependent through the referendum process, the referendum or voting scale shall be open forever, if any selected person lose the referendum at any stage, that lose the status of representative status before Parliament. The referendum scale means something like the recall election system shall be open forever.

Let's take an example, suppose that the Bar Council has a one million members database, whereby 15 advocates file nomination for Parliament representation, in that case, every member of the Bar Council has the right to referendum vote on a nominated person, at 1st level of referendum procedure all 15 members are volunteers. For the 2nd level, only 2-3 volunteers shall be selected on the basis of a higher vote percentage at the 1st level. 2nd level (final) referendum shall be open-based, whereby any member of society has the absolute right to change his referendum right at any time, after 2 level referendum suppose that person A got the higher percentage of the vote shall be designated as a Bar Council representative before Parliament, if during at any time, person A loose the referendum and Person B got the referendum status in his favour, in that case Person B shall be Bar Council representative before Parliament. (Something like as vote recall through online procedure open forever)

#### **Proposed Judiciary System in Contemporary Jurisprudence.**

Mr. Deepak Sharma states that, the Judiciary System is being part of the State, absolutely denied

considered as an independent body, the aforesaid ground having some validity, can't be denied up to initio. He further advocates that public representation shall be required in the Judiciary System; in the same regard he proposed the role of Chartered Law officer in Judiciary Proceedings. He defined a Chartered Law officer as an independent Law officer being a Law qualified person. Judges shall be bound to rely on the Chartered Law Officer report, the selection and report procedure to be done through blind review proceedings of Criminal and Civil or any other matter. On this phenomenon, he proposed the centralised trial proceeding called as J.I.T (Just In Trial) proceeding.

The Just in trial (J.I.T.) is claimed as the World's first centralized trial proceeding provides the edge of public representation in the Judiciary. J.I.T. is considered as 25 times faster and 20 times more transparent against the current Bar - Bench trial proceedings system. The details are not available in the public domain.

**3.9 Mr. Sharma** also propounds some other theory on the Democratic System as

- a. Degree of Democracy (details are not still available in the public domain).
- b. Developing stage of the Judiciary system of any State (details are not available in the public domain).

**3.10. A comparison of Deepak Sharma with others prominent Jurist likewise Bentham, Aristotle, Plato John Austin, Ehlich, Thomas Hobbes and others-** the present Democratic System, political, social, and Judicial System has been developed by various prominent Jurist, philosopher's likewise Human right, Fundamental right, and natural right has been codified by Aristotle and Plato, likewise Bentham and other prominent Jurists propounded the concept of Law, Political Science, and Democratic System. Meanwhile if we count the contribution of Deepak Sharma. He codified the dual representation of Democratic System, types of Law, centralised trial formation, new formation of Judicial Formation, shall be affect the entire Democratic, political and Judicial.

#### **4. A brief of H.R. Economic System and School of Contemporary Jurisprudence -**

As per Mr. Deepak Sharma's theory of the H.R. Economic System, he said that Human resources being the biggest asset of the State, aforesaid assets to be claimed by the State in the National/State H.R account, on-demand aforesaid assets to be

monetised (for a limited time period not a welfare scheme) for the limited time period for purpose of initial capital investment. In support of his theory, he has presented a system as a valuation method, accounting and financial system, and mechanism of manpower grid. If this concept is applied, in that case, capitalism is no more.

As per the theory of Contemporary Jurisprudence-Deepak Sharma said that Parliament or legislative assembly cannot be recognised as an absolute representative of the Republic of State. He proposed the dual-layer parliament System, in which Govt. representatives as elected by Election and in the role of Society representatives. Apart from that he has been denied as Judiciary being an independent body of State. He said that the Bench cannot be treated as an independent body, therefore, society representation is mandatory and is also required in the Judiciary System.

## 5. Conclusion

**5.1 Deepak Sharma is being considered as the Founder of Future Civilisation.** If we have calculated the futuristic impact of H.R. Economic System as well as Contemporary Jurisprudence in brief as below -

- a) **An analysis considering the impact upon the Economic System** - In my opinion, in the consideration of the Human Resource Economic System, capitalism shall be removed from society, the entrepreneurs shall be gaining the power of capitalism, cost of capital for capital investment shall be at a minimum point. The impact of capitalism will be negligible in the Economic System. In consideration of the theory of Contemporary Jurisprudence, Society representation as (representation of Advocates, Entrepreneurs, industrialists, etc.) in the opposition role shall be affect the Govt. power in case of Economic, Financial, and Monetary policy decisions.
- b) **An analysis considering the impact of Democracy** - The present scenario of Parliament and legislative assembly shall be changed, and the rule of politicians shall be removed from Parliament and Legislative Assembly. In Govt. only Elected persons on the ground of capability of how much they are capable to benefit the State, to counter Govt. decisions the representatives of Society as presentative of Students, workers, industrialists, etc., they shall be empowered to fight for development policies, and Govt shall be bound for implementation of Development policies as per there election
- c) **An analysis considering the impact of the Judiciary** - The Bench shall not be supreme for finalise the Judgement, as per the theory of Contemporary Jurisprudence, Courts are mentioned as State body not independent Body of State, therefore present trial proceeding and other Cort proceeding has been denied in Contemporary Jurisprudence. The Just in Trial (J.I.T) an innovative Court procedure System has been introduced, which has been claimed as 25 times faster and 20 times more efficient by Deepak Sharma, in which blind review opinion shall be mandatory by Chartered Law officer, whereas Chartered Law officer is being declared as Member of Society, which is more professional in comparison of Bench or Judges. The J.I.T shall be based on a Centralised Judiciary System. Therefore, a large level of changes is expected after J.I.T implementation.
- d) **An analysis considering the impact of Political Structure** - In my opinion, the entire political system/Structure shall be changed because the role of politicians shall be ended. Most probably only the professional person having the capability of designing the development policy towards in welfare of society shall be elected, and to be formed the Govt., whereas in opposition the representative of Society (representatives of the Students, Workers, industrialists, etc.) shall be in the role of opposition for monitor the performance of Govt, corruption, Crime, policy of Govt. On the other part, the Politics of left-wing, right-wing, socialism and capitalism shall be no more, because of H.R. Economic System being an advanced Economic System shall be removed the relevance of Capitalism and Socialism Worldwide.
- e) **An analysis considering the impact of Social Science** - After considering the both of Concepts in the present Scenario, the present Societal divided into economic class, Caste, Religion etc. shall be more emphasis on their professional class, as member of the Working class, Entrepreneur Class, Professional class, because of H.R. Economic System and Contemporary Jurisprudence have been designed to monetise conversion of Human Resource as well as Parliamentary

representation of Society, therefore a different race for getting membership by professionalism shall be replaced by present Society Shape, on the ground that Economical benefits by Human Resource Economic System.

Therefore, from all observations, I am on the point, that Deepak is considered as founder of our upcoming/futuristic civilisation, and we are capable of drawing a rough picture of the upcoming civilisation.

**5.2 Deepak Sharma is considered for advancement of Human Race for more than 5 decade onward-** [4] as per historical data, Human Race has been got present Two Economic order as Capitalism and Socialism during last 25 centuries, meanwhile Human Race got an Economic order with in last 3-4 years of time period, on the other end Human Race got 5 major jurisprudence during effort made last 25 centuries, meanwhile next generation Jurisprudence has been awarded with in last 3-4 years' time period therefore Mr. is being considered for advancement of Human Civilisation for more than 5 Centuries.

**5.3 Deepak Sharma as a Philosopher-Scientist -** Normally philosophy is not considered a materialist concept, that is the reason, we don't use the scientist word with philosophy, but this is a rare case to use philosopher-scientist because the philosophy given by Deepak Sharma seems to be proved in materialist form -

- a) As per Mr Deepak Sharma. He said that States are mandatory to claim all working Human Resources as an asset in the balance sheet of the State, as on-demand aforesaid assets to be monetised for initial Capital investment to get rid of Capitalism.
- b) As per Mr Sharma, states as in opposition role before parliament, society representation shall be mandatory as representative of workers, farmers, labour, etc. to enhance the degree of Democracy.
